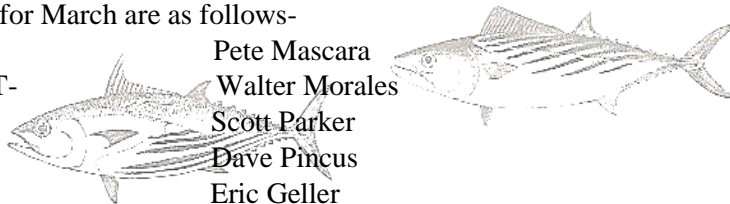
We are planning to have a Skeet Shoot on the Marsh at the Grodski House site on Saturday April 26th.
